

# No fuss activities

### HAVE THESE SUPPLIES AT HAND FOR SELF-DIRECTED ACTIVITIES

#### **INDOORS**

- BOX OF CRAFT SUPPLIES pom-poms, tape, glue, scissors, colored paper, stickers, pipe cleaners, craft sticks, beads, foam paper, glitter paper, feathers, toilet paper rolls...
- BOX OF PAINTING SUPPLIES table cover, paints, brushes, water cup, paper towels, small canvases, rocks, glitter,...
- PLAY DOUGH provide new boxes for newness factor (or make your own), add cookie cutters, rollers, dull knives, etc.
- LEGO CHALLENGE find a list online
- BOREDOM BUSTERS one rule: you have do do whatever you get! Download list on www.globalmobilitytrainer.com/lists
- NAIL ART board, nails, hammer, string. For older children!

#### OUTSIDE

- STREET CHALK challenge kids to draw something new, write something nice, create a labyrinth or game.
  - HUNT FOR BUGS
  - GO ON A PHOTO SAFARI give them a camera and a theme (sets of 5, green things, bikes,...)
- WATER SQUIRTERS need I say more?



## Some preparation

### THESE ACTIVITIES CAN MOSTLY BE DONE INDEPENDENTLY AFTER SET UP AND EXPLAINING

#### **INDOORS**

- TRACE SHADOWS place toy animals or child so that clear shadow is visible on paper,
  Trace and color.
- MAKE "LOOKERS" FOR A SCAVENGER HUNT glue two toilet paper rolls together, decorate, add a ribbon to hang around neck.
- INDOOR SCAVENGER HUNT download free at www.globalmobilitytrainer.com/lists
- MARBLE PAINTING cut a piece of paper to fit in the bottom of a shoe box. Squirt some color on it, drop in 2 marbles. Close lid tightly (use a rubber band!) and shake. Remove lid. Admire art. Repeat.
- PAPER MACHE BOWL cover half a balloon with 4 layers of paper maché and one of white paper. Dry completely between layers. Pop balloon. Remove. Trim edges of paper. Paint or decorate bowl.
- BUBBLE ART fill a pan with dishsoap, a little water and powdered paint. Use a straw to blow bubbles. Gently press white paper down on the bubbles. Let dry.
  You may want to do this outside...

#### OUTSIDE

- MAKE A GIANT BUBBLE BLOWER cut the end off a plastic bottle, tie a sock over the end. Dip into bubble solution (water & dishsoap) and blow into the top so bubbles form through the sock.
